1. Ymddiheiriadau/Apologies Derbyniwyd ymddiheiriadau oddiwrth Eileen Curry Wyn Evans, Beth Davies Cyng Sir Peter Davies /Apologies were received from Wyn Evans, Beth Davies, Carolyn Reid Rees and County Councillor Peter Davies.

2. Datgan Buddiannau/Declarations of Interest: Dim/None

3. Agenda There was an omission on the fourth item on the Agenda and Memorial Park/Children's Play Area should have read Memorial Park/Children's Play Area/Cymdeithas Chwaraeon.

4. Memorial Park

Mrs Marian Bryant addressed the meeting and explained that Ceredigion would be finishing providing funding for upkeep of the Park. Following going out to tender for grasscutting currently the Cymdeithas Chwaraeon groundsman was cutting the grass of the Memorial Park including the Children's Play Area. The total cost for the year for grasscutting and emptying dog and litter bins is £3200. Currently the Park receive rent from the County Council for £300. Mrs Bryant went on to explain that when the County Council took out the agreement with the Memorial Park Trustees that there was a clause that if at any time the Council would be charging for use of the car park the rent would be increased to reflect this. At the moment the County Council was not responding to the requests.

The Community Council explained that as of April the County Council would not be funding the equipment in the Children's Play Area. This is true to all the 13 play area's that the Council look after at the moment. The trustees felt that rather than contacting the Community Council the County Council should have contacted the management Committee of the Memorial Park. It was decided that the clerk contact Mr Paul Arnold to express the strong feeling.

5. Cymdeithas Chwaraeon

Alwyn Phillips for the Cymdeithas Chwaraeon explained that they also had lost significant funding from the County Council. As an organisation that they do a lot of fund raising and sports lotto. As they employ the groundsman they at the end of the financial year bearing in mind that the lotto remains bringing in the same amount of income and commitment from members and would be looking at a shortfall of about £7500.

Cllr Abby Reid explained that she had been looking at the heritage lottery fund. She also explained that if the bid was done correctly and using the park as an entity that there was a possibility of obtaining funding for the park for the next 3 years. She also offered to attend any meeting with the Park Trustees and Cymdeithas Chwaraeon to explain what she had in mind.

She also offered to coordinate the grant application that would build in elements of the Children's Play area, ground maintenance and also a memorial plaque in the park. It was decided that the Park Trustees and the Cymdeithas Chwaraeon go back to their various Committees to discuss the offer.

6. Swimming Pool

As no representation was made from members of the Swimming Pool Committee it was decided that Cllr Peter Evans obtain information by the next meeting of their plans and their financial situation.

7. Floral Display's

The Community Council had been informed by Mr Paul Arnold that as of April the Community Council were finishing funding watering of the flowers in Llandysul.

The cost indicated in the letter seemed high and the members decided that the clerk contact Paul Arnold
